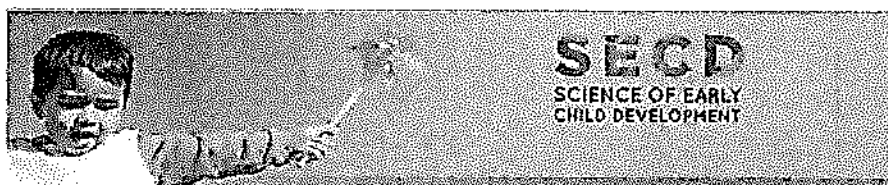

## Science of Early Child Development (SECD)

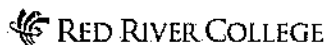
Free province-wide access to a Manitoba portal for SECD resources is available under the Canada-Manitoba Early Learning and Child Care Agreement.
