Subject: **Trans Canada Trail signs**

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Purpose

To provide directional information signing to Trans Canada Trail locations to assist motorists in finding their way to these facilities.

Policy

The Department will permit the installation of signing on the highways providing access to the Trail, according to the following standards:

Standard

- The Department will install the signs on highway right-of-way at the applicant's cost (for sign manufacture and installation). To standardize signing, all signs must be provided and installed by Department forces.
- Normal sign installations consist of an advance sign and an exit sign for each direction.
- Signs will normally be provided on the provincial highway providing the most direct access to the trail, where the trail is within 5 km of the highway.
- The installation of signs must not cause or promote any unsafe traffic operations.
- Space must be available for the installations. (At some complex intersections, it may not be feasible to install signs even though all other installation criteria are met.)
- Access to the trail must be via an all weather route with adequate off-road parking at the trail site.
