Who:	Employers of Apprentices, potential and existing	
Effective Date:	November 1, 2011	

Purpose:

To ensure a basic minimum entry standard for employer participation in apprenticeship training so that apprentices receive a well-rounded educational experience.

Policy:

A proposed employer is eligible to employ apprentices if the employer will commit to adhering to requirements in *The Apprenticeship and Certification Act*, the Apprenticeship and Certification - General Regulation and the relevant trade regulation(s).

An employer is eligible to continue to employ apprentices as long as this commitment is honoured.
