**High Fidelity Wraparound (HFW)** is a strength-based, individualized, step-by-step process for integrating formal and informal services/supports for children/youth with complex, multi-system needs. Coordinated by a HFW facilitator, the process starts with the voice and choice of the child/youth. The facilitator listens to the child/youth to identify short and long-term goals. Then, the facilitator works with the child/youth to build a team of formal (i.e., professional) and informal (e.g., family, friends) supports to help the child/youth accomplish their goals.

The ultimate goal of HFW is to empower the child/youth and to connect them with an integrated team of service providers and informal supports in their community. (The importance of informal supports is a critical piece in HFW – it helps children/youth feel more comfortable in team meetings, and it helps guard against the disruptions in service that can happen in the formal system.) Once pre-determined goals have been achieved and celebrated, the facilitator “peels off” the team, and the team, with the child’s voice and choice still central, continues.
