Child Performer is anyone under the age of 17 who performs as an actor, extra, musician, singer, dancer, entertainer, or a model promoting a product, idea or service.

1. A permit does not apply to workplaces where the Alliance of Canadian Cinema, Television and Radio Artists (ACTRA) is the bargaining agent for the child.

3. A child must not directly or indirectly be charged a fee for seeking or finding work.
4. A child must not directly or indirectly be charged a fee for auditioning, scouting, recruiting or a referral to another agency or recruiter.
