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## **Provincial Park Permit Appendix – Well Site Special Conditions for Wells on the Public Reserve**

*\*Appendix Attached to Permits for Well Sites located on the Public Reserve Only*

1. The permittee hereby releases Her Majesty the Queen, her agents and servants from any and all liability in connection with the use of the subject water supply system/well site or termination thereof as a result of modification, whether natural or artificial of the existing water regime or levels affecting the lake.
2. The permittee hereby acknowledges full responsibility for the construction and maintenance of the subject water system and hereby agrees to construct and maintain the subject water system in a good workmanlike and reasonable manner and shall at all times during the term and currency of this permit indemnify and save harmless Her Majesty the Queen in Right of the Province of Manitoba, her servants and agents from and against any and all public liability, property damage claims, and personal claims arising in respect of the construction, installation, or maintenance, or manner or method of such construction, installation or maintenance of the subject water supply system/well site, or in respect of any defect therein, together with all costs, charges, and expenses arising out of or by reason of the foregoing.
3. The permittee hereby agrees to comply with any and all relevant provincial legislation including The Provincial Parks Act, The Public Health Act, and The Environment Act, and any and all Regulations pursuant thereto. In addition, conformance to the requirements and regulations of Manitoba Hydro in those cases where electricity is required for the operation of the pump facility.
4. Nothing contained in this permit shall be construed so as to make the permittee an agent of Her Majesty the Queen in Right of the Province of Manitoba, it being distinctly understood and agreed that the permittee shall execute, carry out, and implement the terms of this permit on his own behalf and in a safe, prudent, and lawful manner.
