Note to Tenant:

Periodic tenancy: To end a periodic tenancy, you must give the landlord notice of one rental payment period. The notice must be given on the last day of a rental payment period to take effect the last day of the next rental payment period. (e.g. If rent is due on the first of each month, you must give notice on the last day of a month to move out at the end of the next month.)

Fixed-term tenancy: You may only terminate a fixed term tenancy agreement before the end date of the agreement for one of the reasons shown below. Contact the Residential Tenancies Branch at 945-2476 or toll-free 1-800-782-8403 or by email at rtb@gov.mb.ca to find out how much notice you must give and what information you may need to give the landlord with your notice. If you are terminating a fixed term agreement, please check the appropriate box.*
