Note to landlord: The length of notice you are required to give the tenant may vary, depending on the type of tenancy agreement and the location of the rental unit. IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR TENANTS

If you have children attending a school that is close to your rental unit, the landlord cannot force you to move during the school year.

If your unit is a condominium, the landlord may not be able to give you this type of notice to move. Contact the Residential Tenancies Branch at 204-945-2476 or toll-free at 1-800-782-8403 or by email at rtb@gov.mb.ca.

If you move because of this notice, the landlord must pay you compensation for your moving expenses, up to a maximum of \$500.00. If the landlord does not pay you this compensation, you may contact the Branch for assistance. If the landlord does not demolish or convert the rental unit as shown, you may be entitled to additional compensation. Contact the Branch for more information.

If you find a new place to live before the date the landlord has told you to move, you may give the landlord notice that you are moving early. You must give the landlord notice of one rental payment period.
